Board Report

~From the Board~

July was a very busy month for the board and the church as well with 2 board meetings and a special congregational meeting.

First of all, a special board meeting was called for July 6 for the purpose of selecting a settled minister and the negotiated package of salary and compensations to be presented to the congregation. Jean Mueller and the search committee presented Rev. Dr. Don Tharp as a candidate for the position. The board voted unanimously to present him to the congregation.

On July 19, the special congregational meeting was held. Along with the presentation by Jean Mueller and the search committee, Rev. Dr. Don Tharp presented a short message and answered questions from the congregation. The salary and compensations package were also presented. Following a written ballot, it was announced that Rev. Dr. Don Tharp was approved by the congregation. He will start August 1, 2023, and his first Sunday will be August 6.

On July 20, the regular board meeting was held. The minutes of the June 15th board meeting were approved as amended and the July 6th special meeting was approved as presented.

Reports were heard from the various committees and most of that information is included in other articles of this newsletter. Two of the reports are as follows:

Worship Committee

- Worship & Wonder will begin August 20, 2023.
- Once a month for the next year, a special emphasis will be on the Centennial this coming year including music from the different decades.
- Reminders of changes of the service in any way need to be no later than Wednesday morning prior to the Sunday service. Regular information needs to be in Monday morning prior to the service.
- · Need to have an overall captain for the deacons for organization and Personnel.
- · Also need to clarify the acolyte schedule and substitution when needed.

Finance Committee

- The BCC Board requested another bid on the roof to create a taper on the flat roofs with a new membrane for draining.
- · A bid was submitted for \$43,038.45 plus \$100.00 for carpentry repairs if needed in case of rot and mold.
- · The Finance Committee made the recommendation to accept this bid. Under unfinished business, the Finance Committee's recommendation to accept the bid was approved as presented. The Building and Property Committee will meet with Branson /Springfield Roof Company to work on the details of the project.

There was no new business. The meeting adjourned with prayer. The next meeting will be August 17, 2023, at 5:30 PM.

Our last 14 months have been an experience of many blessings. First of all, to have a Search Committee consisting of Jean Mueller (chair), Johnie Groves, John Lea, Annette Sain, Sandy Poos, Robert Baldwin, and Roger Kauffman to commit themselves to hours of meetings, reading profiles, following up references, and interviews was awesome. Our church was well represented in this endeavor to find the right settled minister for us. Please thank them for all that they did.

Secondly, I wish to thank the following people for filling in when we needed someone in the pulpit. There were many times when no one was available from the region, but people from our congregation were willing to help. Those individuals were Johnie Groves, Jerry Yeutter, Jamie Haage, David Faragher, Pat & Larry Campbell, Tilden & Felder Missionary Families and VBS both years. Please thank them as well for all their time and commitment to help our church in this time of need.

Lastly, we have gained new members and have improved programs for our congregation. God has blessed us indeed. Please thank Him for all that He has done for us.
