

#### ~From the Board~

The church board met on Thursday, June 15th at 5:30pm. The following reports were given as well as the others throughout the newsletter:

Building and Grounds: There was much discussion on how to fix the roof. One bid was received for approximately \$15,000 to coat the roof with a special material that would be guaranteed for 20 years. It was suggested that we gather another bid for a pitched roof option so we will pursue that for now. The electronic church sign would need thousands of dollars to repair one side so will get a second opinion.

The 100th anniversary ad hoc committee reported many possible ideas and will continue to meet and refine those plans.

The Pastor search committee stated they are working closely with a potential candidate.

Thanks to all who work diligently on our committees and those who are supportive so the work of BCC can continue.

#### 2023 General Assembly Save the Date

When the General Assembly meets in Louisville, Kentucky July 29-August 1, 2023, it will be the first time in four years the church as a whole has gathered in person. The theme for the **2023 General Assembly** is "Kindom of God Within Us, Among Us." The theme is based on three scriptures: Luke 17:20- 21, Genesis 11:1-9, and 2 Peter 1:3.

The planning committee described the theme, "There are multiple words, scriptures, languages, and ways to share and shape our common life. The church has more than one story to tell, and more than one tool for innovation and distinctive witness in the future. God is with us. What is life before God like? Salt, an open table, zoom, and treasure in clay jars. What have Disciples learned about life before God in the midst of the uncertainty the church and its members faced over the last three years?"

The theme "Kindom of God Within Us, Among Us" is a call for Disciples to strengthen their relationship to God both individually and communally through an expansive in-person and digital gathering of the church in Louisville. The past two years, local congregations and the wider church have needed to be separated but have also innovated new ways for God's limitless love to be revealed in our church, our communities and around the world. God's limitless imagination holds so many possibilities for the church.

This four-day event will encourage Disciples to gather online and in-person to celebrate the way that God's expansive love connects each of us as "kin" and to part of the larger kindom of God. Save the date and join the church <u>July 29-August 1, 2023 for worship, workshops, Bible study, opportunities to explore Louisville, mission, and the sacred work of the church</u>.
