<p>Day 25</p> <p>1 Corinthians 13:7</p> <p>(love)...bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.</p>	<p>Day 26</p> <p>Colossians 1:27</p> <p>To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.</p>	<p>Day 27</p> <p>Colossians 1:23</p> <p>if indeed you continue in the faith, grounded and steadfast, and are not moved away from the hope of the gospel which you heard, which was preached to every creature under heaven, of which I, Paul, became a minister.</p>	<p>Day 28</p> <p>Ephesians 1:18</p> <p>the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints.</p>	<p>Day 29</p> <p>1 Corinthians 9:10</p> <p>Or does He say it altogether for our sakes? For our sakes, no doubt, this is written, that he who plows should plow in hope, and he who threshes in hope should be partaker of his hope.</p>	<p>Day 30</p> <p>Romans 8:24-25</p> <p>For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees?
