

We welcomed 3 new volunteers this month: Mason Feeler, Brenda Archambeau, and Bill Wilson.


Our summer hours are Monday through Wednesday noon to 5pm, Thursdays and Fridays 10am to 5pm, and Saturday 10am to 3pm.

The Christian Education committee strives to provide quality programs for all ages. We focus on fellowship, educational value, and Christian beliefs. The needs of all ages are addressed. While most of our time and energy has been focused on building a strong youth program to ensure the longevity of the church, we also focus on the needs of the adults.

The Wednesday bible study group and Sunday school class continue to flourish. We are currently researching some potential adult retreats. We are also looking into some all-church activities. For the youth we are bringing back more movie nights and craft events. However, just because it says, "youth movie", know that all church members are welcome to come and partake. Be watching the calendar, newsletter, and e-blasts for upcoming events.

If you would like to support the youth and their continued growth, there are two opportunities that many do not know about. We have two designated funds for youth. One is the general youth fund; this provides the funding for events. Through this fund we provide snacks or a meal at each event, supplies for events and admission to things like WinterJam or Young Christians weekend. Our second fund is the Higher Education Fund. Through this fund we provide a monetary gift to our graduating seniors moving on in their education. Gift amounts vary depending on the type of schooling and the intended course of study. Proof of acceptance and registration must be provided before the gift if given. The Education committee also provides each graduating senior with a Bible in the translation of their choice so they can further their spiritual journey. If you would like to give to either of these funds, you can do so by noting on your offering where you would like the monies to go.


