# **BOARD REPORT**

#### ~From the Board Chair~

Another year has begun, and the board is busy working for the church. Our church is blessed with the leaders and committee members that are dedicated to the work that needs to be done.

The Branson Christian Church Board met January 19, 2023, at 5:30 PM. The following committee reports were given:

Building and Grounds/Property--No report was given; however, a letter was read with information that the defibrillators donated from Pat Davis should be shipped in February.

Christian Education—Teen Worship Sunday will start this month. Need volunteers to help in the coming months. Super Souper Bowl Sunday is planned to follow the Youth Sunday Feb. 12 to help raise funds for the upcoming Young Christian's Weekend at Silver Dollar City. An all-church day at Grand Country Splash center Feb. 26 with pizza is being planned. VBS will be June 23-25.

Church Growth & Membership—Planning for the coming year included fellowship dinners, Easter breakfast with the youth serving, church picnic, Thanksgiving Dinner, Hanging of the Greens luncheon, and Adoration Parade. Collaboration with the Christian Education committee for the Souper Bowl Soup luncheon was also discussed. Discussed new ideas to get new members.

Finance—The church ended the year with total income of \$200,665 and expenses of \$128,458. It was noted that the difference was largely due to no minister's salary for several months. Totals receipts for the Thrift Store totaled \$38,134.14, well beyond the \$18,000.00 budgeted.

Outreach—The group discussed collection of food items for Super Bowl Sunday. Also discussed was the Week of Compassion Special Offering to be received February 19 & 26.

Personnel—The group met December 20 and reviewed the secretary's first 90 days and was very impressed with her work. The Love Offering taken for the paid staff was then discussed and distributed to the personnel.

# **Board Report**

Thrift Store--The floor in the back of the store was painted and greatly improved the look of the room. A donated mirror was given to the church for use in the bathrooms. Donations have been very well received.

Worship Committee--The committee reviewed the Christmas Eve and Christmas day services. Plans are being made for the Lenten and Easter season. Ash Wednesday services will be at 6:00 PM on February 22. Lenten devotionals are being ordered and the choir will be performing a cantata. The prayer vigil is being planned as well.

Vision 100/2024—Will be meeting January 24 at 5:00 PM.

Search—Will be reviewing new profiles that have been received.

In new business, the meeting time of the board was reviewed. It was decided to keep the 5:30 PM time.

The other item of business was a request from the Branson Regional Arts Council who has purchased the Owens Theater for granting permission for them to obtain a permit for serving alcohol of any kind in concessions during shows or as a refreshment during art galleries and special events. Their property is within 300 feet of our church and city and state codes do not allow them to apply for a permit without prior written permission from the church. In the past, our church denied a request from another venue for the same reason. The board voted to deny the request for the Branson Regional Arts Council.

The meeting was adjourned with the singing of the Doxology. The next meeting will be held February 16, 2023, at 5:30 PM.







# **Board Report**

### ~From the Board~

The church board met on Thursday, June 15th at 5:30pm. The following reports were given as well as the others throughout the newsletter:

Building and Grounds: There was much discussion on how to fix the roof. One bid was received for approximately \$15,000 to coat the roof with a special material that would be guaranteed for 20 years. It was suggested that we gather another bid for a pitched roof option so we will pursue that for now. The electronic church sign would need thousands of dollars to repair one side so will get a second opinion.

The 100th anniversary ad hoc committee reported many possible ideas and will continue to meet and refine those plans.

The Pastor search committee stated they are working closely with a potential candidate.

Thanks to all who work diligently on our committees and those who are supportive so the work of BCC can continue.

# 2023 General Assembly Save the Date

When the General Assembly meets in Louisville, Kentucky July 29-August 1, 2023, it will be the first time in four years the church as a whole has gathered in person. The theme for the **2023 General Assembly** is "Kindom of God Within Us, Among Us." The theme is based on three scriptures: Luke 17:20- 21, Genesis 11:1-9, and 2 Peter 1:3.

### ~From the Board~

July was a very busy month for the board and the church as well with 2 board meetings and a special congregational meeting.

First of all, a special board meeting was called for July 6 for the purpose of selecting a settled minister and the negotiated package of salary and compensations to be presented to the congregation. Jean Mueller and the search committee presented Rev. Dr. Don Tharp as a candidate for the position. The board voted unanimously to present him to the congregation.

On July 19, the special congregational meeting was held. Along with the presentation by Jean Mueller and the search committee, Rev. Dr. Don Tharp presented a short message and answered questions from the congregation. The salary and compensations package were also presented. Following a written ballot, it was announced that Rev. Dr. Don Tharp was approved by the congregation. He will start August 1, 2023, and his first Sunday will be August 6.

The Search Committee is grateful for your prayers and support as we worked through the process and waited for God to reveal the individual that He had chosen to serve at Branson Christian Church.









# From the Pastor's Desk

### Daily Bible Reading

Nothing has been a more significant part of my spiritual journey than daily Bible reading. My theological grounding and my faith development rely upon keeping close to scripture. That's where we learn about God's love and God's plan and purpose for our lives. My struggle has been how to approach this task. I have read through the Bible many times in many translations. Sometimes I am able to keep my concentration on the text, sometimes my mind wonders. Have you ever experienced this?

Several years ago, the church we attended offered a study by Pastor Brian Hardin that was very inspiring. As we worked through that study, I found out that Pastor Brian has worked for many years helping people all over the world maintain their daily study of God's Word. He calls it Daily Audio Bible. For almost 7 years now Cindy and I have utilized this excellent resource. You can find it at:

### dailyaudiobible.com

You can access all the study help right at this website for free (it is paid for by donations). We prefer to use their free version for our phone: daily audio bible mobile app. We love listening to the daily readings (Old Testament, New Testament, Psalm, and a short Proverb) right before we retire each day. Listening about 20 minutes a day will get you through the entire Bible in a year.

I added their chronological readings a couple of years ago. That is a fascinating read, as you hear the Bible in chronological order (as the best scholars can discern). Again, their family members read the texts of the day, offer some brief explanations, and you can see and read right along with them on the app or online.

Psalm 119:105 tells us, "Thy Word is a lamp unto my feet and a light unto my path." Let daily audio Bible become an enrichment for your faith journey too! Try it out for 30 days, I dare you. Let me know if you find it helpful too!





We would like to take this time to begin the information process to the congregation about plans to refurbish the sanctuary. Plans and objectives have been approved by the board and we would like to begin the information process by providing posters of what the finished Sanctuary would look like as well as hand-outs that will be made available in the Narthex and Fellowship Hall. We will also have a video on the TV in fellowship hall that will show different angles of the Sanctuary in its finished state.
