

From the Pastor's Desk

This week we received a 5-year financial overview for Branson Christian Church. I thought it would be interesting to share some of the specifics with you in this report. This report covers the period from January 1, 2020 - May 31, 2025, so it is not quite 5 years of history.

It is interesting to me that this report includes the entire COVID 19 timeframe, which wiped out so many churches. During this period total income was \$1,153,013. Of that amount, \$217,298 was brought in through our By The Way Thrift Store. A big THANKS to all of you who have helped with that ministry. Total expenses were \$794,250. Total personnel costs were right at 38 percent of those expenses. Property costs were 17 percent. We gave away to world and local missions about 6 percent of our total income.

I want to congratulate each of you who have helped to sustain and move this church forward even during a very difficult time period. You have been faithful and I know God will bless that as we review your surveys and listen for your input to help guide us into the next three years of Ministry.
